The City of Worcester is now too small a local authority to justify a strategic say in matters affecting S Worcs, To improve this archaic picture either its boundaries especially on the SE and SW quadrants should be increased to absorb increasingly urban villages eg Norton and Kempsey. The ward boundaries and in particular the ward names should be changed to reflect the huge changes in population since they were originally set. There is little sense of identity or distinction as between Warndon; Warndon Parish North; Warndon Parish South.. This should be corrected so that people who live in theses areas recognise yheir Ward. Ideally there should be one local authority for South Worcestershire comprising Wychavon, Worcester City and Malvern Hills.
