Currently there are:

- 49 councillors
- 25 wards
- 5 three-councillor wards, 14 two-councillor wards and 6 one-councillor wards

We are proposing:

- 42 councillors
- 20 wards
- 6 three-councillor wards, 10 two-councillor wards and 4 one-councillor wards

A public consultation is open until
10 January 2022



We aim to make sure South
Staffordshire councillors represent a
similar number of electors



Currently there are:

- 6 wards that are more than 10% away from the average number of electors per ward

Our proposals mean that:

- No wards will be more than 10% away from the average number of electors per ward
- Each councillor will represent an average of 2,083 electors
