As a resident of Horsehay & Doseley for more than forty years I am concerned that the proposed new boundaries will split Horsehay into two different wards. It would mean that I am living in Dawley and Aqueduct ward. Horsehay Pool, Horsehay Village Hall, Horsehay Station, Horsehay Golf Club, Horsehay Common, Horsehay Bowling Green and the historic Horsehay Works will all be in Dawley and Aqueduct Ward! This does not make any sense and potentially robs the community of part of its identity. There is a worrying plan to have a boundary down the middle of Woodhouse Lane so people would find themselves in different wards across the same street. Conversely Lightmoor residents will find themselves living in Horsehay and Lightmoor. Councillor David Hopkins has worked out a far better plan where Horsehay and Aqueduct are combined, keep their identity and their names, they would have two councillors. His boundaries do not carve up communities along residential streets. Lightmoor and Dawley Hamlets will also become a two councillor ward, Lightmoor keeps its name and isn't confused with Horsehay.
