

Patcham Ward should include the 'Hollingbury' in its name. I propose this Ward should be called 'Hollingbury and Patcham'. It is wrong that Hollingbury is not in the Ward name as Hollingbury is a distinct and separate neighbourhood and region to Patcham both socially and geographically. Hollingbury is the neighbourhood on the hill above Patcham, bordered to the north by Carden Avenue, to the West by Braydon Avenue, to the south by Surrenden Road and to the east by Ditchling Road. Other Wards have dual names such as Hollingdean and Stanmer and Moulsecoomb and Bevendean. Please rename Patcham Ward Hollingbury and Patcham. Or stop calling Moulsecoomb and Bevendean by 2 names. It is also strange that Withdean Park falls in Patcham Ward when it would make sense that it was in Withdean Ward, especially as it is just a park and doesn't contain any residents. I also think that Withdean should be renamed 'Withdean and Westdene' as you have forgotten that Westdene exists which is a separate and unique community, separate to Withdean.
