### Comment text:

Ward Boundary Change: I agree with Peopleton Parish Council's published opinion that the proposal to amalgamate Peopleton with Drakes Broughton is a poorly thought through change. Drakes Broughton is a very different area to Peopleton, with a much greater population, and bisected by a major A road resulting in some minor but important light industrial development; further housing development is occurring there. Peopleton remains a quiet, off-the-beaten-track, relatively small, & predominantly residential village, with a small community general shop and a relatively small pub and currently very limited development of any sort, with traffic more or less limited to residents travelling in or out of the village, and pupils attending Bowbrook House School, which is the only commercial development of any size within the village: industrial activity is mostly limited to fairly low-key agricultural activity in the parish area surrounding the village, except for a small industrial estate lying well away to the east from the main village on the B4082 at Seaford, and with no direct connection to the main village. The two Parishes are markedly different in their make-up and with markedly different requirements in terms of management; I fear that if brought together the interests and requirements of Peopleton will tend to be always be treated as secondary to the requirements of Drakes Broughton, with its greater population, wider development and much broader range of activities. I am a parishioner of Peopleton, living at Seaford, which is an outlying area of the Parish on the B4082 and where I have lived for more than 50 years. [REDACTED].
