We are writing to say how dismayed we were to find that there is a proposal that Hampton Lovett may become part of a ward with Droitwich Central and Westlands.

Hampton Lovett is a historical parish dating back many hundreds of years and is set in a rural position whereas Droitwich Central and Westlands are definitely urban areas. There is a definite distinction between the two areas eg; type of dwellings and the distance between the two areas.

We are both pensioners who live on Doverdale Park and came approximately 4 years ago to live in a rural setting with a like minded community and peaceful surroundings. We do not wish to be classed as an urban area as we left that environment when we moved to Doverdale Park.

Recently, we had the threat of planning on our green belt countryside surrounding Doverdale Park but after a series of consultations it was dismissed by the high court as Doverdale was classed as a rural setting.
