NEW ELECTORAL ARRANGEMENTS

Currently there are:

- 147 councillors
- 49 wards
- three councillors per ward

985 comments received from local residents and organisations helped shape our recommendations



We aim to make sure that Buckinghamshire councillors represent a similar number of electors

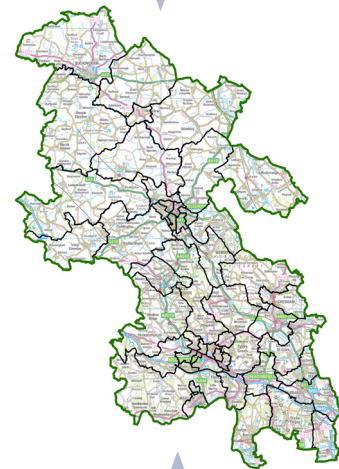


Currently there are:

- eight wards that are more than 10% away from the average number of electors per ward
- one ward that is more than 30% away from the average

From elections in 2025:

- 97 councillors
- 49 wards
- ten three-councillor wards
- 28 two-councillor wards
- eleven single-councillor wards



Buckinghamshire will move towards:

- Three wards being more than 10% away from the average number of electors per ward
- Each councillor representing an average of 4,568 electors
