Corby Town Council have considered the report in detail and make the following recommendations:

Our recommendation keeps estates and traditional areas together. There is a dual carriageway between polling district KIB. There is no linkage between that area and the area it is now placed with. In fact, there is no linkage between that area and LLC , LLD or LLA . This area is traditionally linked with KIE and KIC .

Lloyds/ West

Lloyds is Corby's oldest ward and the proposal cuts streets and the area in half, which does not seem logical.

West is under by -3% and Lloyds is over by +4 %

We believe the alterations below levels up the variances and provides clear boundaries.

We recommend the full length of Studfall Avenue is included within Lloyds with all Studfall homes therefore being in Lloyds ward.
